ARTISAN

a worker in a skilled trade, especially one that involves making things by hand. “street markets where local artisans display handwoven textiles, painted ceramics, and leather goods”

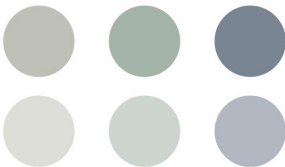
ORIGIN mid 16th century: from French, from Italian artigiano, based on Latin artitus, past participle of *artire* ‘instruct in the arts’, from *ars*, *art*- ‘art’.

NOOK

a corner or recess, especially one offering seclusion or security.
“the nook beside the fire”

ORIGIN Middle English (denoting a corner or fragment): of unknown origin.
